

North Fort Worth Alliance – Goals for 2009

The North Fort Worth Alliance looks forward to 2009 with great enthusiasm.

While we represent 19 communities in our area, we want to enjoin the communities that have yet to become members and reach out to the new communities that are continuing to emerge here in northwest Fort Worth.

The Alliance will investigate and implement ways of better disseminating information to the citizens of our area through better use of our website and other forms of communication, like HOA newsletters and the local newspaper.

We will begin a program to lobby for a more equitable allocation of City resources. While there has been improvement in the coverage of fire department resources, this area still lacks adequate ambulance and police patrols. While the City has committed in the 2008 Bond Proposal to improve certain roads in the area, we will work to obtain more funds to correct several arteries that were not on the final list.

The City passed two bond issues for projects in 2004 and 2008, additionally they have been working on a joint project with the state and Tarrant County to redesign and rebuild Golden Triangle Boulevard. We will monitor the progress of the projects on the list and keep pressure on the City to complete their commitments in accordance with the bond issues wording.

We will work to complete the ZIP Code change we initiated in 2008. We will work with all parties to obtain a favorable resolution to obstacles and to properly inform the residents to be effected.

The Alliance will initiate efforts to obtain a hospital in or very near our area. We will work with landowners, developers and hospital corporations to gain a commitment to build and operate a hospital, so our citizens will not have to be transported to Denton, Grapevine or Fort Worth for treatment.
