**Minutes**

President Rusty Fuller opened the meeting at 9:00.

Rusty introduced our speakers, Representative Matt Krause from Texas House District 93, and Representative Giovanni Capriglione from District 98.

Representative Krause spoke first, as he needed to leave early for his son's soccer game. He summarized the recent legislative session, and the 3 special sessions that followed, highlighting accomplishments of the session. He then took several questions from the group.

Representative Capriglione addressed questions from the group, and reviewed the nine Constitutional Amendments that were on the ballot in November, and answered questions about those.

The General Meeting was adjourned at 10:30, and a meeting of the voting membership (HOA representatives) was attempted, but there was not a quorum present, so no business was conducted. The election of officers was on the agenda, but that will be done by email vote. The nominating committee has offered the following slate of officers for 2014: Rusty Fuller, President; Robert Rouse, Vice-President; and Judi Turner, Secretary.

Rusty made several announcements about road conditions, and encouraged people to write to the Councilman & the Mayor regarding the addition of a police precinct in North Fort Worth.

The VOWS Advisory Committee has waived the usual fee for NFWA to use their facility for our meetings throughout 2014. We extend our deep gratitude to them for this generous offer. Sarah Grimes offered to bring a thank you card to the next meeting for everyone to express their thanks to VOWS.

There will be no meeting in November due to it falling on the same week as Thanksgiving, and we do not normally meet in December. So the next meeting will be January 18, 2014.
