Top 25 Ways to Leverage Our Office for the Good of Your Neighborhood

1. Request to use our conference meeting rooms at Hazel Harvey Peace
2. Link to your public search preview from our online database (web view)
3. Use our database to store your bylaws, important documents, etc. and retrieve them on demand
4. Request a map of your area to help you organize different events
5. Request materials & brochures for your next event or welcome committee
6. Invite your Community Engagement Liaison to your annual or quarterly meetings
7. Ask for follow up & accountability on any community concern or open issue
8. Request more information or next steps concerning conflict management
9. Recommend our office to your local school (TEKS-correlated, education programs)
10. Use our *Recycle Right* presentation to help start a Green Team in your school
11. Use our office if you need to fill volunteer or community service hours
12. Start a business alliance or neighborhood redevelopment organization in your area
13. Engage us in social media (Nextdoor, Facebook, etc.)
14. Use our City Services Map online & request training over the phone
15. Invite us to an event planning meeting (collective brainstorm session)
16. Request our *Community Outreach & Volunteer Recruiting* workshop to increase volunteerism
17. Invite us the next time you canvass your neighborhood door-to-door
18. Forward our online Weekly Bulletin to your neighbors
19. Recommend our office to other civic organizations (Scouts, Jr First Lego League, etc.)
20. Request our *Building Trust, Building Community* workshop for your next leadership retreat
21. Host a potluck dinner for your seniors & invite us to speak
22. Inquire about volunteer opportunities for larger groups (e.g., Wedgewood Park Cleanup Event)
23. Participate in every online questionnaire sent from our office
24. Invite us into future partnerships with schools & businesses
25. Recommend us to your non-profit, church, or faith-based organization
