Mayor Parker – Opening comments

- 360M bond passed in 2022 – Reflects the responsibility we have to look to the future.
- Attracting people and businesses from coastal states

- Water projects are not city money but city driven
- 12 School Districts in FW – Not all are career focused (college and credentials)
- How do we compete with other cities?

  - o Ensuring we remain a safe city – Starts with support of our LEOs
- New public library coming to the far north! 18,000 Sq Ft at 127 Avondale-Haslet Rd, Haslet, TX 76052. Design not started because the public will have opportunities for input before the design process begins.
