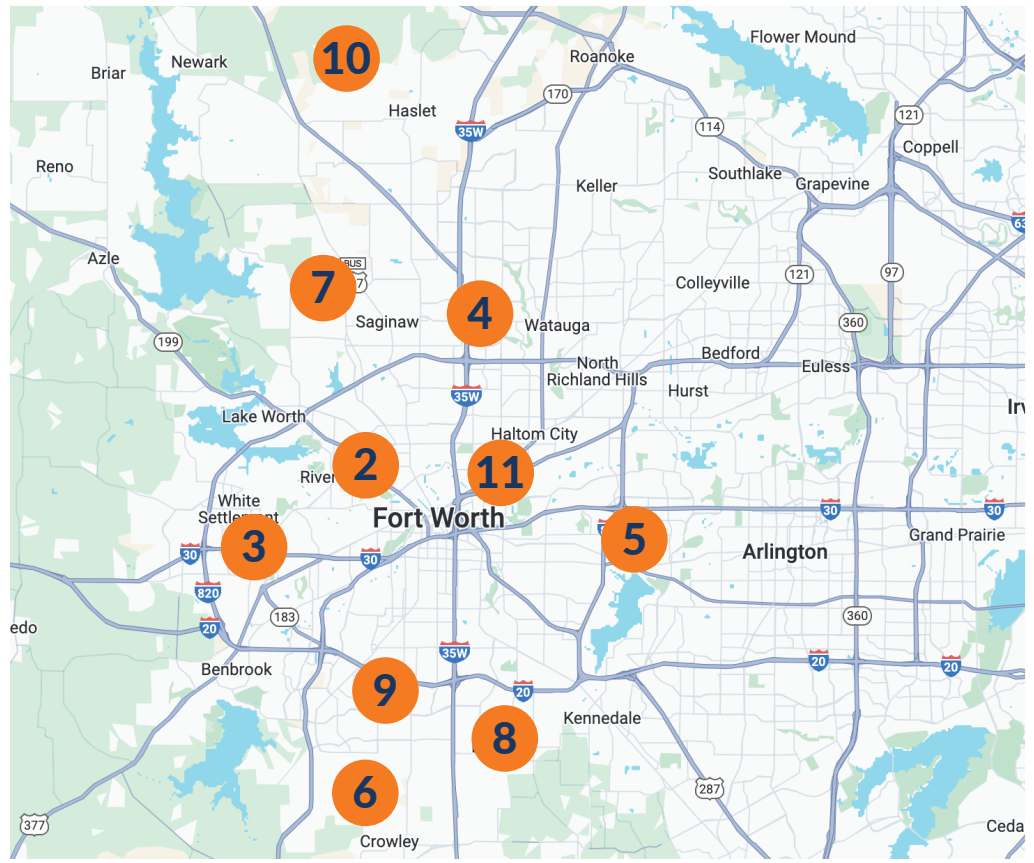
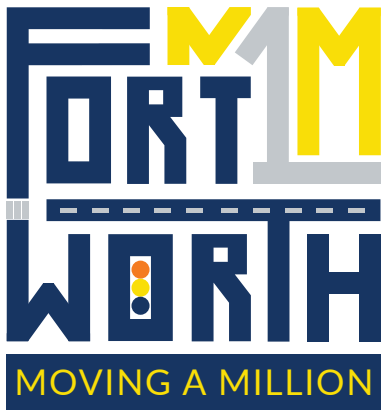
## Vision 0 Safety Action Plan
